Rules 2007-8

A document as given out to the meeting with some suggestions and will discussed at the next meeting. Any other rule changes to be sent to the Secretary for inclusion in this document.

A.O.B

- Richard Dearden asked that Nominations for Lancashire Trials be sent to him sooner rather than later to make sure we do no miss the deadlines this time.
- It was brought to the attention of the committee about substandard umpires and scorers; the secretary reminded clubs that this point in is our rules of how to report these things.
- Walkden brought up about a spare date for the Walkden Torn due to last years being cancelled, the 16th Sept was suggested and Walkden will confirm.

There being no other business the meeting closed at 8.45pm.

Date of the next meeting; Thursday 20th Sept @ 8pm. at Astley Bridge.

Rules changes 2008

- 1. Revise the pitch length for U11's to 20 yards (could be covered using ECB Guidelines)
- 2. Revise the pitch length for U13's to 21 yards (could be covered using ECB Guidelines)

All junior cricket is played to ECB guidelines and directives, then add the above with an appendix and a note pointing out these could be liable to change after the Handbook goes to print.

- 3. To allow a club to have a "B" side in the same league if there is a place spare due to a club not entering that season.
- 4. Revise the age groups to U17's, U14's and U11's

Therefore giving more time to replay matches and to maybe a six a side competition or knockout competition for LKO

- 5. We heed to look at the LKO qualification, because it all depends on whom you play in the first few games too much.
- 6. Each cup date to have a reserve date in the fixtures

This can only be done, if you reduce the age groups.

7. Rained off fixtures: If two clubs can agree any mutual date then the games should be allowed to proceed.

Like they do in a junior football league. There should be a final deadline date for completion any games not completed by this date can then be classed as a draw. It would then be up to the clubs involved to sort out their priority league, the home club would be obliged to give the away club two dates and they could chose one of them if either date was not taken the Section Secretary would set the date for the game to be played.

8. General Rules 6: Remove "may be played on artificial pitch", in other words all games must be played on grass.

REASON, the only club is Greenmount and unfortunately their artificial has a very poor bounce and also gives them an advantage and they also have the best square in the league.

- 9. To allow U11's games not played on a Wednesday evening to be played on Thursday Evening.
- 10. Remove General Rule 27 "Replaying of Cancelled Fixtures".

Make Junior Committee meetings in the season more flexible so the Committee can make the decision on replaying the fixtures - but we are aware time is limited unless you reduce the U18.

- 11. Make U18's cricket one night (therefore freeing up a date for replaying of fixtures)
- 12. In addition to the U18's League ONE DAY League have a 40 over mid week fixture program during school holidays with a maximum of 5 teams per group with a play off

It's time to move out of the 1970s and accept that most lads no longer leave school at 16 and start work

13. If you continue U18 over two nights, introduce a run rate system

(The Bolton League have one, so do other competitions) so if it rains on the first night the second night does not become pointless. You could even have the option on playing to a run rate of restarting the match.


