Rule Changes	For	Against	Abstain
<p>The Bolton League will organise competitions for junior players at Under 11, 13, 15 Under 9 and Under 18s can be played between those clubs that wish to participate in a League. Under 11, 13 and 15 are compulsory. However a club may opt of one of the compulsory age group providing they are running a team at the age group below. This includes U11's but you must be running a U9's Team All fixtures dates will be set by the BCL – but the U18's dates may need to be slight varied due to Senior Cricket.</p>			
<p>At U11's level increase the number of players to 10 per side. (League and Cup) This would mean 20 over games Batters bat for 4 over per pair Bowlers max 4 over per bowler.</p>
