Ideas document changes for Season 2014

A discussion was held in relation to an ideas document send out by MB from disussions that had been held from the last 3 meeting. Each point was discussed and either kept or rejected. Following on from this disussion MH ststed that a meeting would be called between the Seniors and the Juniors to dissuss all rules changes for 2014 some-time in Oct 2013.

Below are the ideas that are to be carried forward:

Allow Coloured clothing.

U9's - pairs cricket 8 a side or 6 a side

U11's – you can choose at Jan meeting from Pairs cricket 8 a side or normal cricket 11 a side. (must be 4 or more teams in either unless all play the majority game).

U13's - you can choose at Jan meeting from Pairs cricket 10 a side or normal cricket 11 a side. (must be 4 or more teams in either unless all play the majority game).

U15's -11 a side normal cricket

U18's- a third team eg can have up to 4 over aged players as long as they have not played more than five 1st team games in the last 3 years. With play by dates not fixed

Age groups U9's, U11's and U13's (Compulsory) and U15's (not compulsory)

Alternative: leave compulsory age group as 2013.

Form an official U9's League

Rules Changes 2014 (except from the above if nothing happens) U18's

Add rule" In the event of teams having an equal number of points, the order of merit shall be decided according to the ratio of runs per wicket scored divided by runs per wicket conceded, over all Two Day League matches played, (Highest ratio first)"

U13's

- 6. A batsman to retire when he has scored 25 runs. (was 30)
- 7. No bowler is to bowl more than Three overs. *(was 4)

U11's

Remove all league prizes and cups. Give every play a participation medal.
