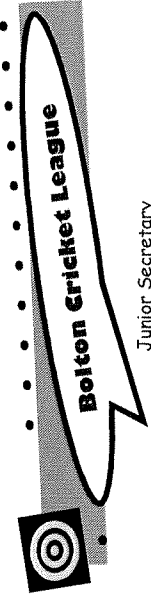

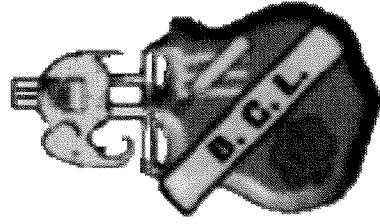
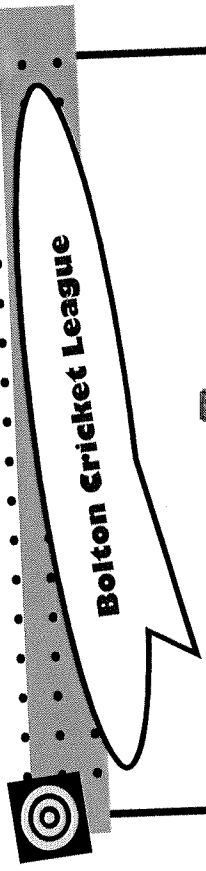

How to we get there?

At Club Level:

4 teams playing in junior cricket (U11, 13, 15, 18's)

Clubs will be encouraged to contact their local schools, posters and promotional ideas will be distributed.

To have all team managers do Child Protection and First Aid Courses.

A Child Protection Course as been organised for Tuesday 13th March and First Aid Course for Mid April Details out soon.

To have a UKCC2 coach in each club.

The BCL will apply again for a UKCC1 and UKCC2 courses as per this year, giving clubs the opportunity to send there people.

At League Level:

Master-classes / Professionals Sessions

These will be advertised as and when they are available.

Interleague Monthly Sessions

Once per month, the Interleague squads will meet at all levels .Grounds will be selected for these sessions to take place.

Wicket Keeping Course

Regular sessions will be held starting with indoor and moving outdoor in the summer

One to One Coaching

To be run as and when required.

Structured summer programme to include clubs summers schools.

To co-ordinate the clubs summers schools so that they don't clash.

Winter Sessions at ONE location but revised to participation sessions and Interleague / District Standard sessions.

Learning from winter 2006-7, it is suggested that we have two sessions. EG 11/5 hour Participation and 1 1/5 advanced..

Coaching Committee to be put in-charge of Interleague Cricket

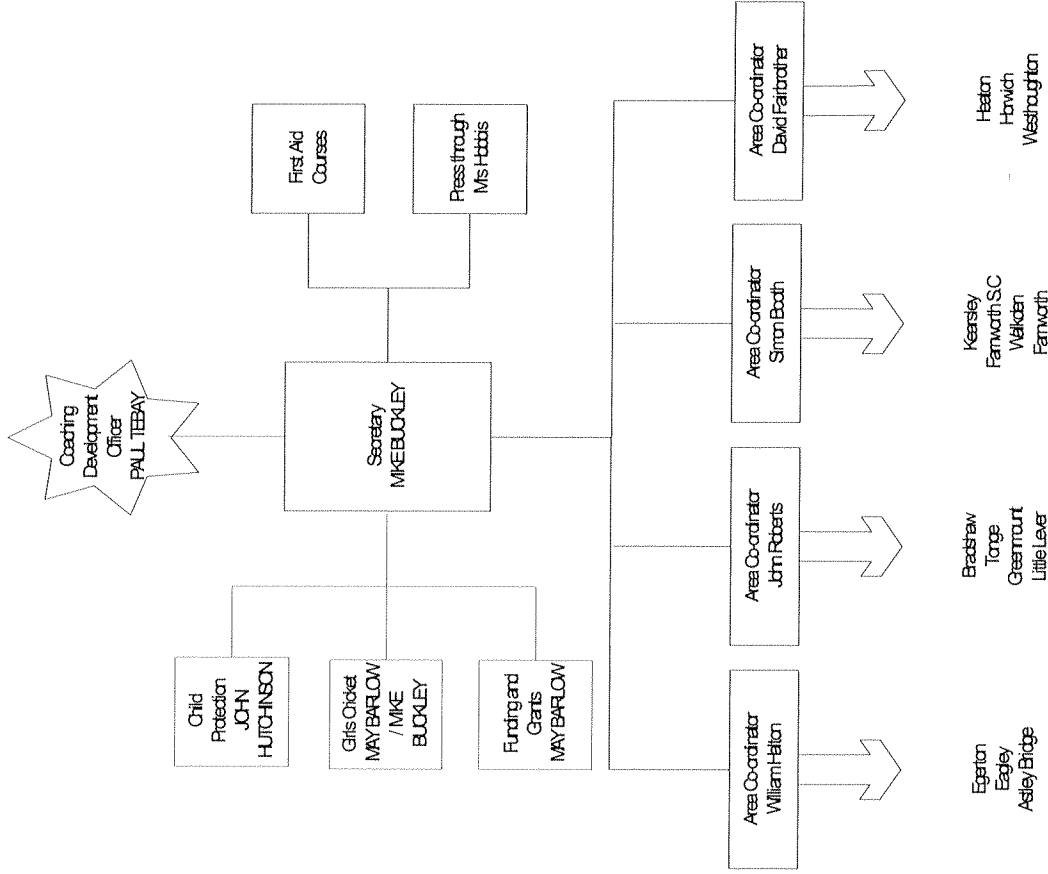
This would help in the co-ordination between the clubs and league sessions including the monthly session and one to one coaching ultimately leading to talent ID.

To encourage Girls cricket

Bradshaw / Little Lever to run month girls sessions that any girl from any club can attend.

Aims and Objectives for 2007

This structure is to be put in place so that information can be passed to clubs quickly and smoothly.

The area co-ordinators will be in contact with their clubs and they will deal with any help or assistance the club requires.

The club co-ordinator job is to identify and inform the Area Co-ordinator of any help or courses they require and this information will be forward to the Secretary who will try and organise a course or coaching session, through the coaching development officer.

The squad will be based at PONTIN'S PRESTATYN where they will have full use of all the facilities. Accommodation will be in shared units.

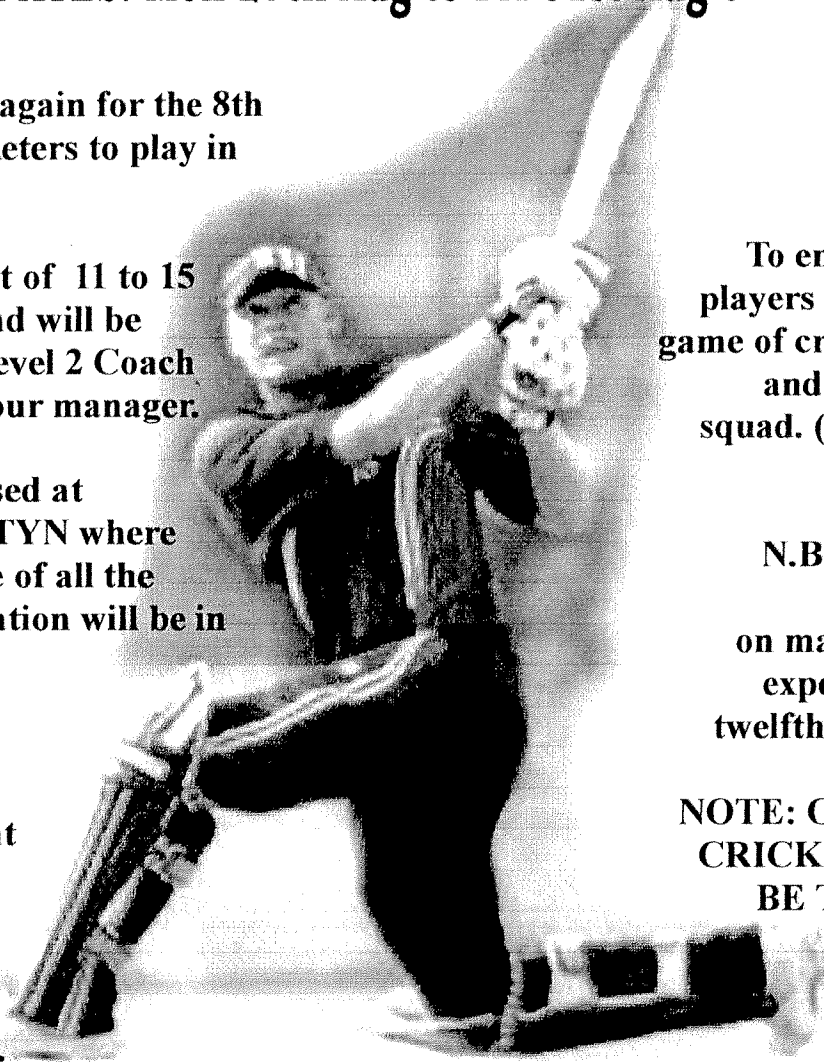
The squad will play 4 matches and each member will play in at least 3 matches, there will also be a morning coaching sessions.
